Program Dates:

- Replant period: Program ends May 15, 2007 in south and east Texas (geography south of I-10); Submit crop replant claims by June 1, 2007.
- Replant period (Remaining southwest geography Oklahoma, Kansas, New Mexico, and West Texas: Program ends July 1, 2007; Submit crop replant claims by July 15, 2007.
- Crop destruct period: Ends on August 31, 2007 for the entire southwest geography.
- September 15, 2007 – Last day to submit crop destruct claims.

Essential Program Elements: Southwest District - FiberMax Cotton Seed and AFD Cotton Seed:

- Eligible growers who plant either FiberMax/AFD Cotton Seed varieties and plant 100% of their cotton acres or a minimum of 25 bags or 1250 lbs of FiberMax/AFD Cotton Seed are eligible for program.
- Original planting must be with Qualifying FiberMax Cotton Seed and/or AFD Cotton Seed varieties.
- If the original variety is not available then another FiberMax Cotton Seed and/or AFD Cotton Seed variety must be substituted.
- Eligible events covered for replant are any crops destroyed by an act of God, limited to wind, hail or flooding events. Loss of early season cotton stands due to soil crusting, cold temperatures, disease and insects are not covered.
- Only offered for the first replanting of the season and does not cover multiple replant situations.

Replant: Temik® 15G Brand Insecticides, Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide and AERIS Seed-Applied System Insecticide Requirements:

- Replant with a FiberMax Cotton Seed and/or AFD Cotton Seed variety with same technology.
- Must have purchased and applied a minimum of 700 lbs of Temik® 15G Brand Insecticide or 25 bags of FiberMax Cotton Seed /AFD Cotton Seed treated with Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide in 2007.
- Must have applied at least 3.5 lbs of Temik 15G Brand Insecticide per acre or the labeled use rate of Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide on first planting.
- If Temik 15G Brand Insecticide was used on the first planting then Temik 15G Brand Insecticide, Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide, or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide must be used on the replanted seed
 - Temik 15G Brand Insecticide will be reimbursed up to the cost of the initial Temik 15G Brand Insecticide used.
 - Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide will be reimbursed at the actual cost of the seed treatment.
- If Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide was used on the first planting Temik 15G Brand Insecticide, Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide must be used on the replanted seed and will be reimbursed up to the cost of the Gaucho Grande Seed Applied Insecticide or AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide, whichever was used on the first planting..

Crop Destruct Requirements:

- Only Liberty Link varieties are eligible. LibertyLink Bollgard II® trait refund will be provide by appropriate trait provider. Contact Monsanto for any potential rebate on Bollgard II.
- Affected acres cannot be replanted back to cotton within the same calendar year and must be destroyed prior to harvest on or before August 31, 2007.
- Ignite® 280 reimbursement up to use rate of 58 ounces of Ignite® 280 herbicide per acre – minimum purchase and application of 20 gallons of Ignite® 280 herbicide in 2007.

Claims:

- Reimbursement will be paid on second purchase of products.
- Seed dealer contacts the local BCS Sales Representative within 10 days of the crop failure.
- BCS Sales Representative will verify the need for replant or crop destruct.
- Fraudulent reporting of sales and product use are grounds for withholding or invalidating all program money.

The grower must furnish original receipts for 1st and 2nd purchases of FiberMax Cotton Seed and/or AFD Cotton Seed, Temik 15G Brand Insecticide, Gaucho Grande Seed-Applied Insecticide, AERIS Seed Applied System Insecticide and/or Ignite 280 herbicide if the sales are not reported electronically to Data Dimensions™. Eligible events covered for replant are any crops destroyed by an act of God, limited to wind, hail or flooding events. Loss of early season cotton stands due to soil crusting, cold temperatures, disease and insects are not covered.
