PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

To reward the utilization of Best Management Practices and to share in grower risk of losing his/her cotton crop or serious reduction in yield on the final cotton planting due to drought.

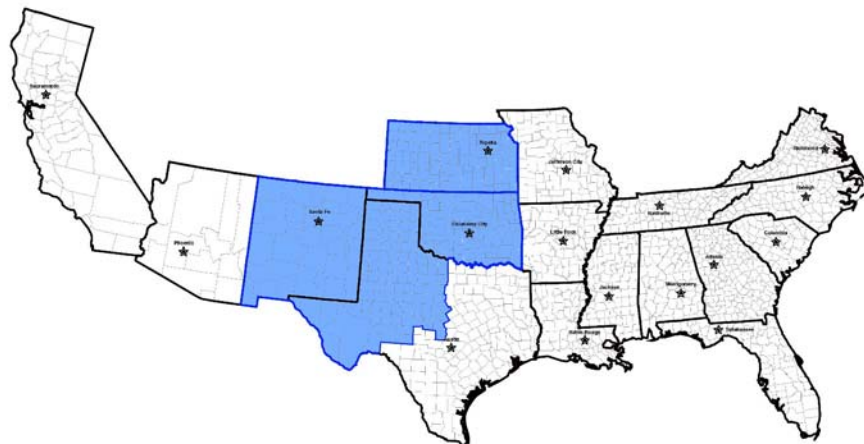
PROGRAM PERIOD

Drought Program: April 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007

ELIGIBLE GROWERS

Cotton growers who utilize qualifying products purchased from a Bayer CropScience (BCS) authorized distributor, retailer or agent whose production area is in Kansas, New Mexico, Oklahoma and/or the counties in West Texas listed below.

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

Growing Practices:

- Growers must utilize sound farm management practices, following university extension recommendations and making every attempt to establish a stand and produce a crop to its maximum potential.

General Program Requirements:

- The program applies to all acres planted with FiberMax Cotton Seed and/or AFD Cotton Seed.
- Grower identifies all potential fields that yield less than 150 lbs of lint per land acre and notifies BCS of all potential cotton fields planted to Qualified Products that are anticipated to be lost or may not meet the 150 lbs lint per land acre, due to drought. This initial registration of potential drought loss fields must be submitted by September 15, 2007. Grower will provide field identification, variety(ies) planted, acres affected and the location and name of the seed retailer where seed was purchased.
- Grower agrees to allow inspection of field by BCS representative.
- If fields qualify, grower must file a claim with BCS by December 31, 2007.
- All supporting documentation, proof of seed purchase, insurance documents and gin recaps (if harvested) must be filed with BCS sales representative by January 15, 2008.

LibertyLink Drought:

- If yield is less than 150 lbs lint/Land Acre for qualifying FiberMax and AFD Cotton Seed containing LibertyLink Technology.

- If a grower's eligible cotton crop fails due to drought then (BCS) will reimburse the grower the set price for purchase of qualified FiberMax Cotton Seed and AFD Cotton Seed containing LibertyLink Technology(ies). (See Table A on page 3)

All claims procedures from "2007 Southwest Shared Risk Program for FiberMax Cotton Seed and AFD Cotton Seeds apply.

- As part of supporting claims documentation, provide the BCS sales rep with the appropriate Federal crop insurance claim documentation substantiating crop destruct or estimated yield of less than 150 lbs of per land acre due to drought under the Multiple Peril Crop Insurance Coverage for affected acres. Total eligible acres equal the grower's reported acres of cotton for the USDA or Federal Crop Insurance.
