The natural refuge option does not apply to **Bollgard II** cotton grown in areas where pink bollworm is a pest, including CA, AZ, NM, and the above listed Texas counties. It also remains the case that **Bollgard® and Bollgard II** cotton cannot be planted south of Highway 60 in Florida, and that **Bollgard** cotton cannot be planted in certain other counties in the Texas panhandle. Refer to the Technology Use Guide and IRM Guide for additional information regarding Bollgard II, Bollgard, natural refuge and EPA-mandated geographical restrictions on the planting of Bt cotton.
