



2020 CROPLAN[®] Cotton Drought Relief Program

OFFER

If due to drought, a certified dryland CROPLAN cotton crop is planted, and yields less than 175 lbs. of lint per acre and drought is the primary cause contributing to 50% or great of the claim damage under the Multiple Peril Crop Insurance coverage for the affected areas the crop will be considered a loss and program will apply.

If the crop planted to CROPLAN yields less than 175 lbs lbs. lint per acre as estimated on a crop insurance claim form, due to drought and the grower harvests the field, the grower will qualify for \$280 in a credit which will be applied to the retailer by WinField United.

If due to drought the crop planted is *not* harvested and yield as estimated on a crop insurance claim form is less than 175 lbs. of lint per acre, the grower will qualify for \$240 in a credit which will be applied to the retailer by WinField United*.

Program is valid only for the 2019-2020 crop year in Bayer's published Seed Drop Rate Zone E (which includes the states of OK, NM, KS and certain West Texas counties). Please contact your local dealer to confirm geographical eligibility.

PROGRAM TIMING

September 1, 2019 – January 10, 2021

QUALIFYING PARTICIPANTS

All growers that plant CROPLAN cotton variety on certified dryland acres.

QUALIFYING GEOGRAPHY

Zone E, as identified by Bayer official seed drop zones.

QUALIFYING PRODUCTS

All CROPLAN commercial cotton products.



PROGRAM CONDITIONS

Program is valid only for CROPLAN cotton seed purchased during the 2019-2020 crop year program and covers certified dryland acres only.

Program applies only to crop losses and/or yield reductions due to drought conditions. *Losses or reductions due to other conditions or perils, such as disease, pests, hail, wind, etc. are not eligible under this program.*

Acres must be covered under the Multi Peril Crop Insurance program. Growers must use sound farm best management practices, and make every attempt to establish a stand and produce a crop.

Claims on a unit of seed can only be made under one program. Seed previously qualifying for refund under the CROPLAN Replant or Crop Loss program is ineligible for the CROPLAN Drought Relief Program.

An authorized CROPLAN seed sales representative must inspect potential claims while the crop is still in the field and has the right to reject without settlement on any potential claim not inspected before harvest. A CROPLAN seed sales representative must verify claim and complete any and all documentation prior to filing claim in order to be eligible for reimbursement.

Final deadline for submitting claims in Zone E is January 10, 2021.

Claims must include Federal Crop Insurance Claim detailing drought as cause of crop loss and that actual harvested or estimated yield is less than 175 lbs. per acre due to drought on dryland cotton acres. A FSA 578 form certifying acres as dryland or non-irrigated, proof of purchase, and production record if harvested is also required to be eligible for reimbursement. Settlement for seed will be issued via credit to the retailer upon approval of claim and corresponding sales reported for the farm.

REQUIREMENTS

Must be enrolled as an AgriMine[®] System customer to qualify. Cotton purchases will be taken from AgriMine System.
